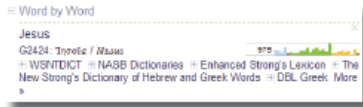
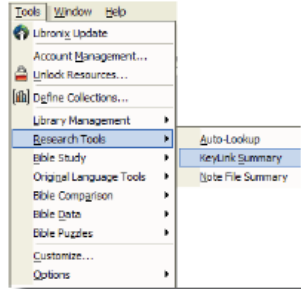


Knead : Word Meanings

Please remember that even though I lay out Thought Structure and Word Meanings as separate steps you'll probably be conducting them almost simultaneously. This means as you're using Exegetical Guide and Bible Word Study for syntax and morphology you'll also be using them for word meanings. You'll wear out the Word by Word section of the Exegetical Guide.



Another feature you want to consider here is the KeyLink Summary found out Tools | Research Tools. This automated report allows you to access your dictionaries and lexicons for any word at anytime. In other words you don't have to be in another report like the Passage Guide to open this report. If you like this report, consider adding it to your toolbar.



Knead : Context

Once again for emphasis, Context is listed as a separate sequential step but in practice you'll examine word usage as you're investigating Thought Structure and Word Meanings. When you get to individual word study you normally examine all aspects of the word at the same time.

The Bible Word Study report is great for providing automatic searches for the occurrences of each word. In Matthew 28:16-20 you certainly want to study other occurrences of the Greek words for authority, make disciples, and nations.

As you're becoming familiar with the program though, it's time to start accessing the various search dialogs from the Search menu. Depending on your passage you may need to conduct word, phrase, proximity or morphological searches. For example, with Matthew 28:16-20 these would be interesting searches:

- The phrase *in heaven and on earth*
- The phrase *in the name*
- The words *baptize and name* in the same verse
- The imperatives or commands of Jesus in the gospels
