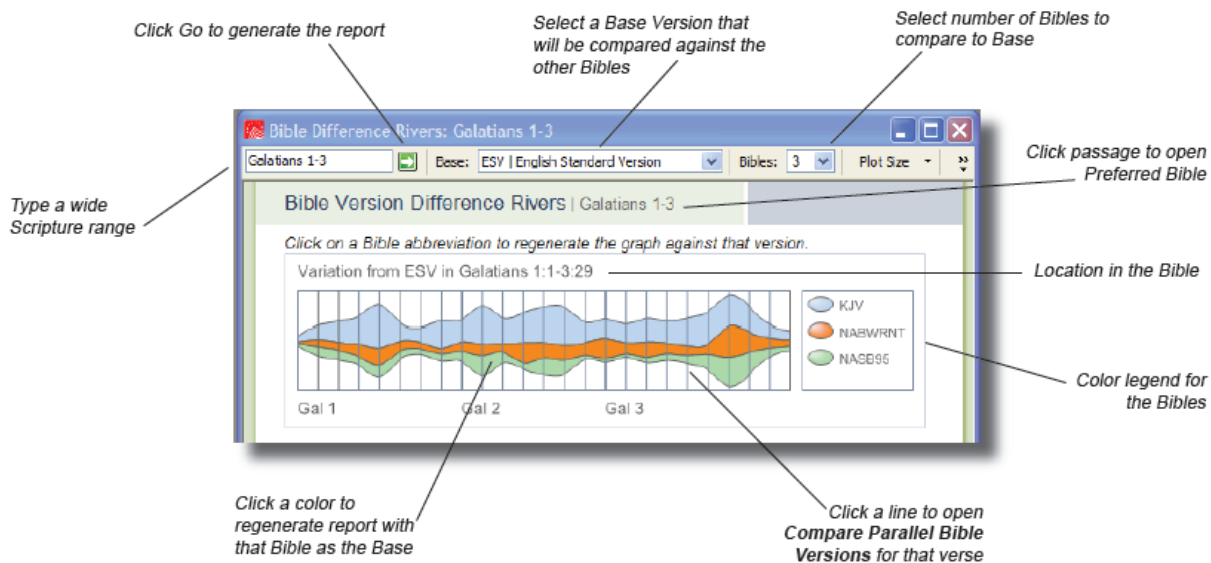

Bible Version Difference Rivers

Bible Version Difference Rivers is located at **Tools | Bible Comparison | Bible Version Difference Rivers**.

1. Open the report
2. Select the **Base** version of the Bible to be used in the report from the drop down list (all of the other Bibles in the report will be compared to the Base version)
3. Select the number of **Bibles** to be compared against the Base version from the drop down list
4. Select the specific Bibles to be compared against the Base version:
 - Choose **Tools | Options | KeyLink**
 - Click **KeyLinking**
 - Select **Bible** as the **Data Type** from the drop down list
 - Select a specific Bible from the list of Bibles and click **Promote**
 - Repeat the above step for as many Bibles as you desire
 - Click **Close**
5. Select a **Plot Size** for the report from the drop down list
6. Type a Bible passage (a large range like a Bible chapter works best) in the passage box
7. Click the **Go** icon on the report's toolbar (or press the **Enter** key)

As you read the report keep in mind:

- Each Bible compared against the base is represented with a color.
- Each "river" represents a comparison between the Base Version and the Bible in the "river".
- The broader the "river" the more disagreement the Base and the compared Bible have.
- The black vertical lines passing through the "rivers" are the Bible locations.
- Rest the cursor on a black vertical line to see a popup of the current location.
- Click a black vertical line to generate a Compare Parallel Versions Report for that location.
- Click a Bible abbreviation or color either in the "river" or the legend to generate another Bible Version Difference Rivers report with that Bible as the Base Version.
- To open your Preferred Bible to the passage click the Bible reference at the top of the report.
