


Right Mouse Search Options

When you right click on a word or phrase in a Bible you'll have several search options:

- **Speed Search This Resource** will search the entire Bible you're currently in through the Bible Speed Search
- **Speed Search All Open Resources** will search all of the open books on the screen
- **Speed Search All Resources** will search your entire library
- **Search** will open the Bible Search dialog so you adjust the search ranges

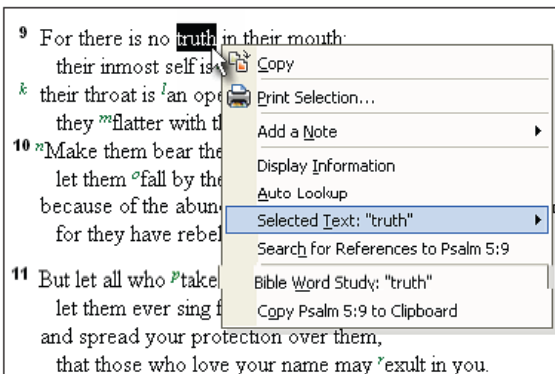

Word Search

To search for a word in the Bible via the right mouse:

1. Right click on a word in the Biblical text
2. Select from the right menu "**Selected Text: 'your word'**"
3. Select your desired search option



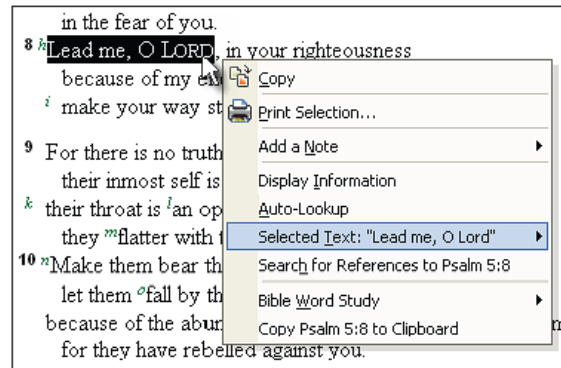
Tip

When you already have a Bible open the right mouse Bible search is the fastest way to search the Bible. From the right menu options just select **Search** and the **Bible Search** dialog opens. Your word or phrase is already inserted into the **Search** box. All you have to do is adjust the ranges.

Phrase Search

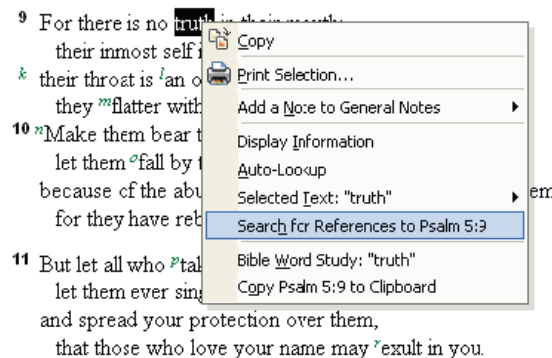
To search for a phrase in the Bible via the right mouse:

- Select or highlight a phrase in the Biblical text
- Right click on the highlighted phrase
- Select from the right menu "**Selected Text: 'your phrase'**"
- Select your desired search option



Bible Verse Searching

When you right click anywhere within a verse in a Bible the right menu contains **Search for References to 'your verse'**. This option searches your entire library for every occurrence of your verse.



Bible Cross Reference

When you right click on a blue Bible cross reference in a commentary, dictionary, etc. the right menu contains "**Selected Reference: your verse**" and then the various search options. From here you can search any portion of your library for occurrences of this reference.
